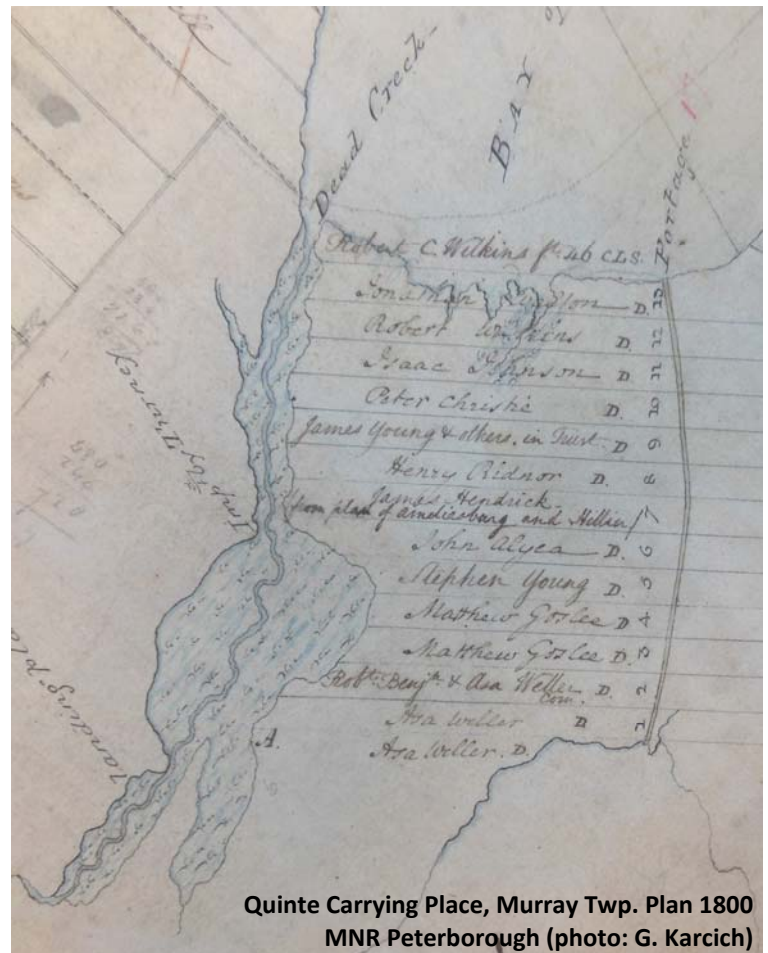

Major Trails, Portages and Carrying Places from Toronto to the Bay of Quinte

This talk will focus on the archaeological and historical evidence for trails along the north shore of Lake Ontario and into the interior lakes such as Chemong, Rice, Balsam, and Simcoe.

Artifacts found near and along the trail routes will be discussed as well as the routes these trails followed as they appeared on 17th—19th century maps of the region.

The talk will outline where the current locations of these trails can be found. The trails covered are the Quinte Carrying Place, the Chemong Portage, the Ganaraska Portage, the Scugog Carrying Place, the Wick Portage, the Talbot Portage, and the Toronto Carrying Place—both the Humber and the Rouge River branches.
